All Counsellors have appropriate training and are affiliated to, or members of NZAC or NZCCA (the professional counselling bodies).

We are affiliated to NZ Federation of Family Budgeting Services Inc and all our Budget Advisers are trained and certificated to the Federation standard of competency.

In January 2010 we appointed a Seniors Community Support person to address the specific needs of supporting seniors living at home.

We rely on donations, grants, bequests and receive some contract funding from MSD.

We provide a free and confidential service where individuals can be assisted with all aspects of their personal budget, including:

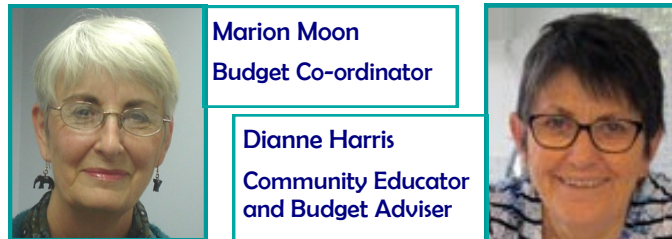
- ◆ Preparing a budget and cash flow

- ◆ Bank statement covering one full month
- ◆ Pay slip, details of income or your benefit breakdown
- ◆ Loan/hire purchase agreements
- ◆ Details of rent/mortgage
- ◆ Details or letters regarding outstanding debt
- ◆ Details of any court orders or fines
- ◆ Regular costs such as power, phone, rates

If you are living with a partner and sharing income and/or costs, if possible, come together and provide details of both incomes and outgoings.
