Rev Neil Fuge—who had the original vision—was present to join the festivities and he and Natalie cut the special cake made and iced by Dorothy Rowlands.



The Budget service is affiliated to the New Zealand Federation of Family Budgeting Services Inc and a number of Budget Adviser training courses have been facilitated by the Care Centre. Services are provided in Whangarei, Kamo, The Pulse and Waipu.

These are confidential and professional services performed in a caring and safe atmosphere.

Clients may self-refer or be referred by other agencies or professionals such as Doctors.

We network with, and receive referrals from, approximately 30 other agencies.
